



## Tripod Jar

**Description**

Three parrots support a jar in the form of a tropical seedpod or gourd. Vessels of this shape are common in shaft-chamber tombs of West Mexico where they contained mortuary offerings. The tripod supports were comprised of either human or zoomorphic forms.
