



## Ceremonial Blouse (Cofradia Huipil)

**Medium**

cotton, silk and dye

**Description**

The distinctive sunburst neckline used by

Chichicastenango weavers indicates where this otherwise rather unusual huipil was made. Against a white cotton background, the artist brocaded large multi-colored diamonds interspersed with flowers. She also incorporated silk rosettes at each shoulder.
